The Business Affairs Committee (BAC) met via a phone conference call meeting on March 2nd. The focus for the meeting was to discuss per capita within the presbytery. A decision was made to send a letter to thank all the congregations who submit 100% of their per capita. Mike Selburg was selected by the group to take over moderating the committee to replace Julie Raffety.

BAC met in person at Stronghold on March 28th. LouAnn Breckinridge shared the financial reports. She also shared that she was seeking retirement from her position as Treasurer for Blackhawk Presbytery by the end of 2017, and is willing to retire as soon as we have a replacement for her. A lot of progress was made on ideas of how to engage in conversation and build relationships with congregations who are not paying 100% of per capita.
