Katy Steinberg is a cradle Presbyterian born to Susan and Rev. Larry Cuthill, a PCUSA pastor. She spent her childhood with church as second home, and an eye toward travel and business. After completing her degree in Business Administration at the University of Florida, and a few years of work in that field, Katy felt called to seminary. She completed a Masters of Divinity at Columbia and Dubuque Theological Seminaries over the next several years and rounded out her education with church experience in Youth and Children directorships.

However, she always felt called to reach the people outside the church, and the PC(USA) **1001 New Worshipping Communities** movement created the right partnership to do so. Katy took advantage of their apprenticeship, coaching, and grants to found **Missing Peace** (a New Worshipping Community in Ormond Beach, FL) in 2015 with a goal of reaching unchurched and dechurched people with dynamic worship in varied locations.

Since that time, she has led a number of workshops and published multiple articles and videos on the topic of doing church differently in our changing times. In addition to leading the effort to reach new people in Ormond Beach, she is active on Committee on Preparation for Ministry, Church Development Council, Evangelism Committee at the Presbytery and in coaching and evaluating other burgeoning leaders in the 1001 movement.
